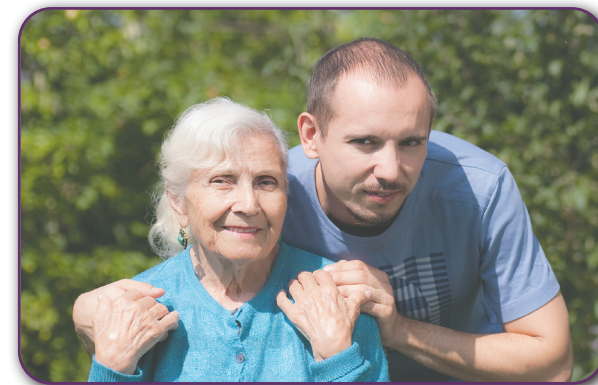

Adult Day Health Services

Adult Day Health Care is a therapeutic day program that provides care to enhance the independence and quality of life **for adults age 18 and older** with physical and behavioral health conditions, and provides respite for family caregivers. Our program is licensed by the state of California and staff is professionally licensed and trained to provide quality care and services.

Our program includes:

- Nursing supervision of medications, medical care, and treatments
- Social work case management
- Physical, occupational, speech, and nutritional therapies
- Individual and group exercise
- Behavioral health services
- Personal care services
- Nutritious snack and lunch
- Recreational activities and special events
- Round-trip transportation from your home



Affordable Care

The daily fees to attend the Adult Day Health Care program are affordable and much less than the cost of an in-home caregiver. Please talk to us about your specific insurance coverage and needs. Program fees are covered by:

- Partnership HealthPlan of California
- Veteran's Administration
- Redwood Coast Regional Center
- Caregiver respite grants
- Private payment
